## Frequently Asked Questions

### Community Benefit Grants and Community Events/Sponsorship Programs

1. What areas do you serve?

“Our service area encompasses the cities in Northern Alameda County and West Contra Costa County. If your target population is in a different service area we will refer you to the designated branch.”

2. Who qualifies for funding?

“Non profit 501(c)3 organizations and public entities who serve vulnerable populations in the East Bay service area and have programs specific to our funding priorities. Please review our grant application for a detailed description of our funding priorities - <http://oakland.kaiser.org/cb>.”

3. How often do your funding priorities change?

“Every three years a Needs Assessment is conducted to determine our funding priorities. Our next Needs Assessment will be conducted in 2010.”

4. If an event is held in San Francisco or any city outside your service area can our agency still apply for a sponsorship grant with your office?

“Yes, if your organization serves our local population in Northern Alameda County and West Contra Costa County then you may apply to our program.”

5. When are the evaluation reports due?

“Responsive grant reports are due January 15, 2009 & July 31, 2009 for 2008 grant recipients. Community Activities/Sponsorship reports have a due date designed on the award letter.”

6. What's the length of time it will take to receive our funds?

“If approved for a grant or sponsorship check processing takes on average 6-8 weeks. Please call us if you have not received your check in a timely manner.”
