

## Department of Allergy – Redwood City Patient Information Sheet for Allergy Appointments

Welcome to the Allergy Department. Please read the following helpful tips to make your first visit pleasant and productive.

Your first appointment in the Allergy department will consist of a 30-minute consultation with an Allergy and Asthma specialist. Skin testing **may** or **may not** be performed during this visit. If skin testing is ordered, you will need to spend an additional hour in the clinic.

Skin testing may <u>NOT</u> be done if:

- You are pregnant
- You are taking beta blocker medication (e.g. Atenolol)
- You can not stop taking antihistamines or certain antidepressants (see below for details)
- You are ill or wheezing
- You are under the age of 18, unless accompanied by a parent/legal guardian

Skin testing is performed by applying a small amount of antigen/allergen with a disposable device, either on the forearm or the back. In some cases, additional skin testing may be recommended which is usually done on a subsequent visit.

In order to assure accurate skin testing results, you must **discontinue antihistamines** for the appropriate length of time, which varies for different medications as follows:

7 days prior to visit	Allegra (Fexofenadine), Atarax (Hydroxyzine), Astelin (Azelastine), Zyrtec (Cetirizne), if possible discontinue [Elavil (Amitriptyline), Nortriptyline]
3 days prior to visit	Claritin (Loratadine), Deconamine, Chlorpheniramine, Dimetapp (Brompheniramine), Other cough and cold medicine (Nyquil, Tylenol PM, Advil or Tylenol Cold and Allergy)
1 days prior to visit	

Do not stop taking your cortisone nasal sprays and medication prescribed for other medical conditions. Please call the Allergy department at (650) 299-2485 if you have any questions regarding your medications.

## For asthma and chronic cough patients, a breathing test may be ordered. If possible stop the following medications:

6 hours prior to visit12 hours prior to visit24 hours prior to visitSpiriva

## On the day of your appointment:

- Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment to fill out an allergy questionnaire.
- Please be considerate to other members and call us 48 prior to you appointment if you need to cancel or reschedule.
