

## **SEMEN ANALYSIS INSTRUCTIONS**

- Your semen sample is to be collected by **masturbation only.** Sexual **abstinence of 2-3 days** is required. The entire ejaculate should be placed into the sterile plastic container supplied by your provider or by any laboratory.
- Do not use baby oil or other lubricants. These products are toxic to sperm.
- Semen transferred from a condom are not acceptable. Many condoms contain spermicides or lubricants that are toxic to sperm and some of the sample may adhere to the condom resulting in an alteration of the sperm concentrations.
- The **container must be labeled** with your name, medical record number and the collection date and time.
- Your semen sample should be protected from temperature extremes and agitation during transport to the laboratory. Keeping **the specimen at body temperature** by placing the cup close to your body is best.
- Your semen sample **must be delivered to the laboratory within 60 minutes** after the collection to maintain the reliability of the motility and agglutination determinations.

• Semen samples for fertility may **ONLY** be delivered to one of the following Kaiser Laboratories:

(The laboratory *will not accept* semen samples on *weekends or holidays*)

The Sacramento Medical Center (2025 Morse Ave) is the only laboratory that can perform a **Kruger** analysis, so if your doctor has included a Kruger analysis as well as the basic semen analysis you must take your sample to the laboratory at the **Sacramento Medical Center on Morse Ave** (see above).
