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WEEKLY Labs are required - No fasting is necessary

Get these labs drawn at your local KP at least once before starting the treatment and then every week during the concurrent chemoradiation. Please get the labs done during the week, such as on a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday, so that any abnormal results will be viewed by the neuro-oncology staff during the work-week so that we may intervene if necessary.

We will not routinely contact you if the labs are within an acceptable range, however will contact you if there is an abnormal result that requires an action/intervention. You are welcome to contact us as anytime if you have questions or concerns about your labs or other health issues.

- CBC with Differential (Complete blood count)
 Needs to be checked every WEEK
- Comprehensive metabolic panel (liver & kidney tests)
 Only to be checked once per month

MRI brain and another neuro-oncology visit should occur 2-4 weeks after the radiation is completed.

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
